

GENERAL

Disc golf is a game in which players throw a flying disc into a basket. The object of the game is to traverse the course from beginning to end in the fewest number of throws of the disc. The competitor who plays the round in the fewest throws is the winner. For full game rules, visit www.PDGA.com

COURSE COURTESY

Allow faster players to play through. Please pick up trash. Donations are greatly appreciated; they help fund maintenance, improvements and keeping the course looking great!

THROWING

Throws must be completed within or behind the designated throw area. Do not throw until the players in front of you are out of range. The player's subsequent throw is made from directly behind where the previous throw landed.

COMPLETION OF THE HOLE

A disc that comes to rest in the disc basket or chains constitutes a successful completion of that hole.

PENALTIES

A one-throw penalty is added to the player's score for the following infractions: out-of-bounds and water hazards.


MANDATORIES

A mandatory ("mando") is a designated tree or pole in the fairway that the disc must pass on the correct side, as indicated by an arrow, before the hole is completed.

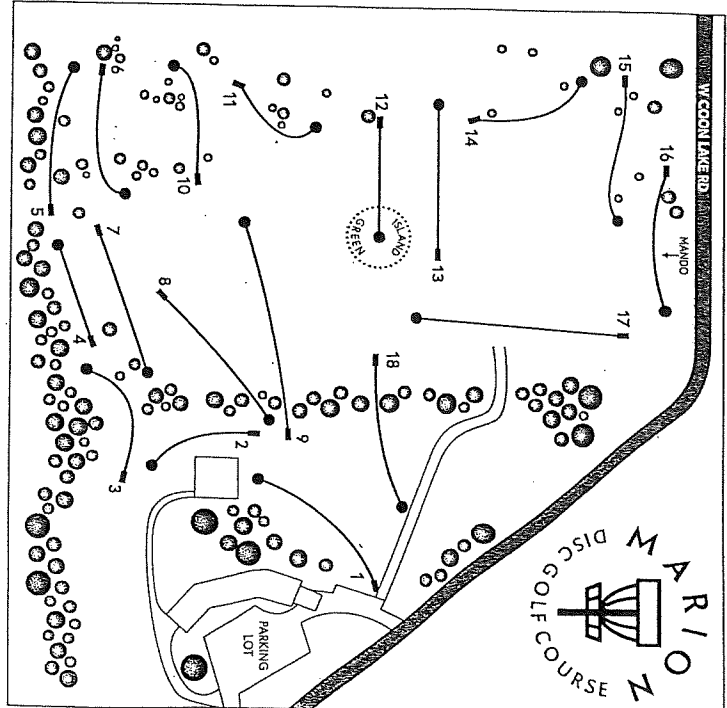
ISLAND GREENS

An island green is the area around a hole that is encircled with rocks. A player's first throw from the tee pad must come to rest within the rock circle. If the disc comes to rest outside of the circle, the player must make their second throw from the designated drop zone.
